Dear Mr. Wolf:

This is a follow-up to our 14 December 2000 response to your request, under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), for records concerning **Jorge Eliécer Gaitán**. Pursuant to the appellate court's decision issued 16 January 2007, we have conducted searches for the records whose existence has been disclosed by the Central Intelligence Agency.

We have completed searches for thirteen reports from which Central Intelligence Agency Director Admiral Hillenkoetter read excerpts to a congressional committee in 1948, and which may contain information responsive to your request. Admiral Hillenkoetter identified the reports by the following dates:

We located two reports, dated 26 January 1948 and 29 January 1948, both of which mention Mr. Gaitán. Please be advised that our analysts believe that the report dated 26 January 1948 may be responsive to Item 2 (22 January 1948). We have reviewed the two documents and have determined that they can be released in segregable form with deletions made on the bases of FOIA exemptions (b)(1) and (b)(3). The two documents, as approved for release, are enclosed. We were unable to locate any of the remaining eleven documents.
